



**EMERGENCY ACTION NEEDED:
Don't wait to respond, we need your help now.**

Please help us keep our equestrian trails open! A new Wildlife Resource Rule is being proposed to stop equestrian access to the William Silver Gameland. These lands have traditionally been utilized by equestrians and we are working to preserve our access. This is where you come in! We need at least 15 letters sent to the Office of Administrative Hearings (email and address below) to stop these new proposed rules for a year until we can reach some compromise with the Wildlife Resource Commission.

I have pasted a copy of the letter of objection to the proposed Wildlife Gameland Rules below. Please copy and paste the language below into an email and send it to oah.rules@oah.nc.gov, or mail a hard copy to the address in the body of the message. If sending an email, the subject line should read **"Objection to Rule 15A NCAC 10D .0103."**

We need as many objections as possible and the letters do not need to come from an affected party. Therefore, we are all able to submit objections. Please send these in immediately and then let me know that you have sent an email or letter, so I know how many we have. You are free to circulate this correspondence to any and all who you think will be willing to help their fellow horsemen and horsewomen.
